Captain's Choice Rules

- I. **The Golf Match – Captain's Choice** – Every player tees off, and the team captain selects the best shot to play from. All team members then hit their next shots from that chosen spot. This process continues until the ball is holed. The Captain's Choice has become a common golf format at charity and corporate tournaments. Because, unlike traditional stroke play, this team-based format encourages collaboration and cooperation among players.
 - I. **Team Formation:** Players form teams of two or more individuals. The group size can vary, but it's typically four players.
 - II. **Tee Shots:** On each hole, all team members tee off. The team captain then chooses the best tee shot among them.
 - III. **Starting Point:** The spot where the selected tee shot lands becomes the starting point for all team members for the remainder of the hole.
 - IV. **Play Continues:** All team members play their next shots in succession from the chosen starting point. This process continues until the ball is holed out.
 - V. **Scoring:** The team records the score for the hole based on the number of strokes it took to complete it. The team with the lowest score on a hole wins that hole.
 - VI. **Overall Score:** The team's overall score is the sum of its scores on each hole. The team with the lowest total score at the end of the round wins the Captain's Choice game.

Etiquette In Captain's Choice Golf -

- i. **Maintain the Course:** Repair ball marks, fill divots, and rake bunkers to leave the course in good condition for the next players.
 - ii. **Pace of Play:** Keep a steady pace of play. Be ready to hit your shots when it's your turn, and avoid unnecessary delays.
 - iii. **Quiet on the Green:** Keep noise and movement to a minimum when players are putting on the green.
 - iv. **Safety:** Be aware of your surroundings and the safety of others on the course. Shout 'fore' if your shot might hit someone.
 - v. **Honoring Traditions:** While Captain's Choice is a fun format, it's essential to respect the traditions and rules of golf. For more details on Captain's Choice and Golf Etiquette, visit <https://golfreply.com/what-is-Captain's-choice-in-golf/>.
2. **Player Tees and Colors**
 - ❖ Gentlemen 60 Years and Older – White Tees
 - ❖ Gentlemen 59 and Younger – Blue Tees
 - ❖ Ladies All Ages – Red Tees
3. **Closest to the Pin/Hole** – There are 2 holes designated for "Closest to the Hole", Hole # 3 and Hole # 16. Please ensure that you sign the book located at the green to record your shot.
4. **Longest Drive** - There is 1 hole designated for "Longest Drive", Hole # 18. The ball must come to rest on the main fairway cut . There are three categories based on the tee color: Blue, White, and Red. Please ensure that you sign the book located at the green to record your shot.

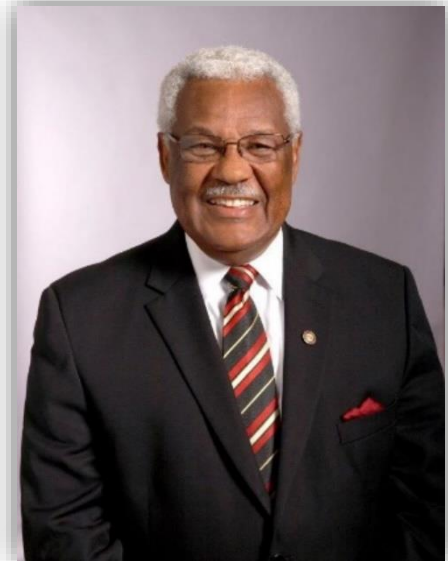
